Fee Increase Term 2, 2007

Recreation Skill Certificate Testing

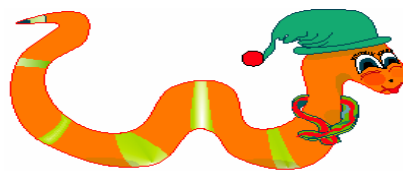
