### **Spotters.**

The organisers are asking clubs to nominate spotters to be available for a session in advance so we are not calling for spotters on the day. This is to ensure the competition runs smoothly.

We are therefore asking if each Christchurch based club could nominate a spotter for each session. If any outside of Christchurch clubs have parents attending who would be prepared to volunteer to spot for any session please can you let us know.

## **Timetable.**

The timetable is attached to this newsletter. We plan to run all three disciplines for each group within one session to reduce the time athletes need to be at the venue. The time given for each session is the time the trampolines will be available for warm up. Each group will be competing events in the following order; Synchro, individual trampoline and DMT. Prizegiving will be held at the end of each session.
